



Easter Blooming Flower Crowns

Something to make to illustrate another part of the Easter Story. Use it to encourage children to talk about their flower crowns and how they are different to the crown of thorns Jesus wore on the cross.

You'll need:

- Paper plates, (paint or colour in green)
- Tissue paper or ordinary coloured paper,
- Scissors
- Glue.

Making Your Easter Blooming Flower Crowns

1. Cut eight flower shapes from coloured paper, or make scrunched up flowers from tissue paper. If you have younger children make stencils they can trace
2. Cut a slit in the centre of each paper plate and then cut it in triangle slices like a cake. Make sure all the triangles stay attached or it won't sit on your head
3. Bend the triangle shapes up to form leaves. Lastly, glue the flowers onto the tips of the leaves.
